In winter, the St. Anton am Arlberg region is a paradise for all snow sports enthusiasts. Alongside breathtaking mountain panoramas and snow-covered valleys, Austria's largest ski area, Ski Arlberg, offers over 300 kilometers of pistes and more than 200 kilometers of freeride terrain. Carve your turns on groomed slopes and snowy powder fields, and enjoy ski days like never before. Explore the region without skis on cross-country trails, feel the tranquility of nature while snowshoe hiking, indulge in culinary highlights at local restaurants and huts, or embark on a guided ski tour into the snow-covered mountain worlds.

Outdoor enthusiasts will never be bored in St. Anton am Arlberg. Whether on an (e-)mountain bike to crystal-clear lakes or hiking amidst lush alpine meadows, the gateway to the mountains is open year-round, with diverse mountain sports opportunities easily accessible within short distances.



The Villages in the Arlberg Region

St. Anton am Arlberg

Visitors appreciate the alpine coziness at 1,304 meters above sea level, as much as the hospitality and international flair. A mountain village that is both traditional and modern, surrounded by the stunning nature of towering peaks and the conveniences of a cosmopolitan resort town.

St. Christoph am Arlberg

At around 1,800 meters, St. Christoph am Arlberg is one of the highest alpine ski resorts. This small village boasts a long history. In the 14th century, the shepherd Heinrich Findelkind established a hospice here for weather-stricken travelers, laying the foundation for the charitable Brotherhood of St. Christoph, which now has nearly 20,000 members worldwide. The Arlberg Hospiz Hotel, today a renowned hotel, was the founding site of the Ski-Club Arlberg in 1901.



The Valley Villages

Pettneu am Arlberg

Nestled between the majestic peaks of the Lechtal Alps and the Verwall Group, Pettneu am Arlberg sits at 1,228 meters above sea level. As a neighboring town of St. Anton am Arlberg, it is an excellent starting point for (winter) hikes, as well as mountain and ski tours. The village of Schnann (1,180m) belongs to Pettneu, home to the romantic Schnanner Klamm (accessible only in summer). The ski slopes of St. Anton am Arlberg can be reached in just a few minutes via ski buses.



Flirsch

The small village, rich in historic charm, is situated at 1,157 meters and offers winter sports enthusiasts a local ski lift, particularly suited for children and beginners. Numerous winter hiking trails, opportunities for ski tours, a cross-country ski trail leading to St. Anton am Arlberg, and a toboggan run complete the offerings. The St. Anton am Arlberg ski area is also just a few minutes away, reachable via a ski bus.



Strengen

At the entrance of the Stanzertal valley, the municipality of Strengen, at 1,027 meters, impresses with its typically Romanesque appearance. The St. Anton am Arlberg ski area can be reached within minutes by bus. Those who prefer to climb the mountains themselves can take a ski or snowshoe tour to the Dawinalm. A cleared winter hiking trail also leads walkers and toboggan enthusiasts to Egger Weiher, a naturally formed body of water above the village.

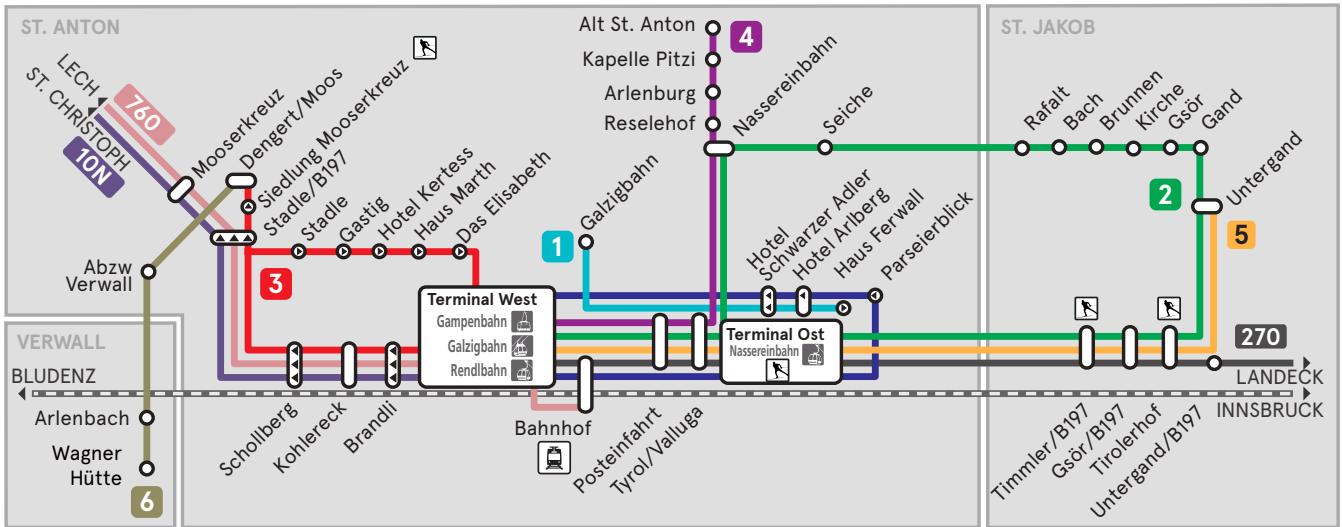

- 2)** **Ski pass purchase the day before for the following day:** The passes can be used from 4 pm the day before they become valid. Ski passes are only valid on consecutive days.

- 6)** **Family bonus:** When purchasing Ski Arlberg season passes, the third and all younger siblings (children or youths according to the tariff regulations) of a family receive the Ski Arlberg season pass free of charge, provided that at least one parent and their first and second child (children or youths according to the tariff regulations) of the same family purchase a Ski Arlberg season pass. The family relationship must be proven in an appropriate manner (official IDs, etc.). All ski passes must be purchased together and at the same time.

Recommended winter walks

Discover snow-covered landscapes, idyllic ponds and breathtaking views on a winter hike - ideal for nature lovers and connoisseurs. Our recommendations range from leisurely circular routes to panoramic trails at an altitude of over 2000 metres:



St. Christoph (3 km)

High altitude trail at 1,800 m. The varied high-altitude trail to the 'Arlberg Thaja' mountain restaurant begins right at the top of the Arlberg Pass.



Panorama path Galzig

(1 km)

Winter hike at over 2,000 metres from the Galzig mountain station to the St. Christoph mountain station.



Verwall (10 km)

Flat hike from the Mooserkreuz, past the Wagner Hütte to the Verwallsee.



Ganderau (3 km)

Flat circular hiking trail in the St. Jakob am Arlberg area to the Ganderau Landscape Park between the district of Vadiesen in Pettneu am Arlberg and St. Jakob am Arlberg.

Gasthof Almfrieden

(6 km)

From Pettneu am Arlberg, the hike leads up to Gasthof Almfrieden, from where you can enjoy a marvellous view over the Stanzertal valley.



Egger Weiher (2 km)

This hike leads along a forest path to the Egger Weiher pond in Strengen.

Trails

St. Anton am Arlberg has more than 40 kilometres of cross-country ski trails. The network of cross-country ski trails has numerous leisurely as well as sporty variants and therefore offers plenty of variety. The majority of the trails are groomed for classic cross-country skiing and skating.



Stanzertal (22 km)

The trail starts at the recycling centre in St. Anton and runs along the Rosanna on a gentle slope. It leads through all the villages in the region to Flirsch and back. Caution: A blind bend after the first few kilometres requires particular caution.



St. Christoph (2,5 km)

An approximately 1,800 metre long circuit with short ascents and descents, ideal for meeting up with alpine skiers on the sun terraces of St. Christoph.



Verwall (10 km)

Starting at the Hotel Mooserkreuz, this scenic and challenging trail leads through the romantic Verwalltal valley and circles the Verwallsee lake. The constant alternation between descents and ascents requires a good level of fitness.



Ganderau (3 km)

An easy route, ideal for beginners and less experienced cross-country skiers. The start is either to the east of the Hotel Tirolerhof or at the fire station in St. Jakob am Arlberg.



Pofel (1,5 km)

This short but varied trail in Pettneu runs between the River Rosanna and the motorway. It offers ascents and descents and is ideal for a quick training session.



Reit (2 km)

A flat circuit to the east of Pettneu, which is connected to the Stanzertal cross-country ski trail. This route is ideal for short and effective training.



Football pitch Pettneu (2 km)

A flat, easy trail to the west of the Arlberg Stanzertal wellness park in Pettneu. This trail leads through the Rosanna stadium by the football pitch, among other places.



Night cross country skiing (2 km)

In winter, there is a night cross-country ski run with floodlights along the 'Pettneu football pitch' trail, which takes place every Monday and Friday from dusk until around 21:00 from December to March.

Toboggan runs

In the middle of the winter sports area, the Gampen attracts visitors with its 4,5 kilometre long natural toboggan run. The starting point at 1,850 metres can be easily reached by cable car from Nasserein. Once at the top, the fast and winding route takes you 500 metres down into the valley. The toboggan run, which is classed as moderately difficult but is also suitable for beginners and families, takes around 15 minutes (secured with side snow barriers).

Toboggan evening:

On Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6.00 pm to 9.30 pm there is a toboggan evening on the Gampen. The Gampen Restaurant at the start and Thony's halfway down the run invite you to stop off and savour regional delicacies. Toboggans can be hired at the Nassereinbahn valley station and at Thony's.

Please note: Whether the toboggan run is open and the toboggan evening takes place depends on the snow and weather conditions. Current information can be found externally at arlbergerbergbahnen.com.

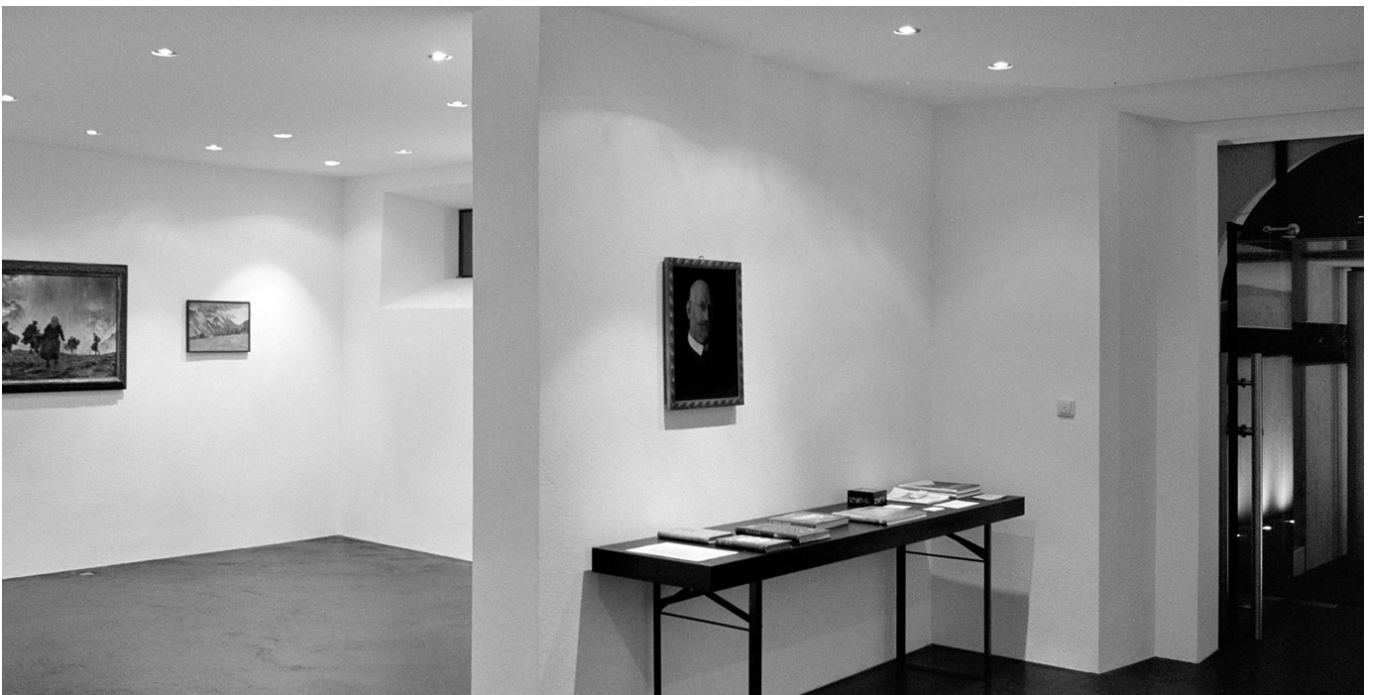
